ROUND ROBIN POLICY	Version # 1

Purpose: <ul style="list-style-type: none">To provide opportunities for Club members to play social tennis with members at their own skill level.	
Policy: <ul style="list-style-type: none">Round robin sessions are open to all Club members.Participation in round robin sessions will be organized by volunteer Coordinators at each level.The round robin program will be overseen by a Club Round Robin Coordinator.League players must play at their own level unless invited by another level's Coordinator to fill in vacancies.Non-league players (STARS, social members) may be moved up or down a level by the Club Round Robin Coordinator in consultation with the level Coordinator.Players are expected to show up a few minutes early to be ready to start play on time.Courts will be allocated for 1.5 hours; players will play three rounds of one half hour, with the level Coordinator calling final serve one minute prior to the end of the half hour.Rotation guides from EVSTL will be available through the VPTC website.All Coordinators are responsible to the Vice-President.	
PROCEDURES:	
STEP 1	Players who wish to participate in their level's round robin event must sign up through the Club's Event Registration system by 8am on the day of the event.
STEP 2	Level Coordinators will organize the event according to the numbers who have signed up, and will attempt to fill any vacancies prior to the event.
STEP 3	If any courts are not needed, the level Coordinator will advise the Vice-President so courts can be released for general use.
STEP 4	Players who need to cancel their sign up must do so before 8am on the day of the event.
